




Print design

When printing designs in GIS Design Print the Title can be designed more flexible.

In the print dialog in the Page section the title line is now with two lines possible. There are different predefined macros available to place design information to the title line.



If the '?' Button is pressed, a window appears with the macros which can be inserted to the title text at the actual cursor position.



The following macros are available:

- %N Design number %M Design name %P Folder
- %V Version %C Customer %F Filename.

As shown in the example above in addition to the Design number and name, which are no longer obligatory to a design, also the filename and folder path can be given, which enables unique identification of a design.

In this example a design is printed, which is stored with filename "RollsRoys Oldie". The design description holds the information as shown.
