


BasePac 10 text-import file for template

The import files for Text Import at template operation are structured as follows:

1. Every line contains the text for one embroidery field
2. If the line starts with a number, so this is used as count. This means, the following text is repeated as many times as the number gives.
3. the lines in the embroidery field are separated with | or TAB.
4. If at the line end (in front of the |) is a ~nn, where nn is a one or two digit number so nn gives the needle number which is used to embroider this line.

Example:

Using the three lines template:



With all lines defined with default needle 1, with the following text file:

```
Max|Muster|Musterstadt
2 Tom~2|Test~3|Testdorf~4
3 Viktor|Versuch~5|Versuchort
4 Fred~6|Farbe~7|Farbhausen~8
2 Norbert|Normal|Normingen
```

The output to the embroidery machine will look as follows:
